Responsibility and Obligation Acknowledgement Form

- Maintain a specified GPA
- Participate in conferences, workshops, and seminars as organized by the FIU and National SFS programs (e.g., the CyberCorp® Scholarship for Service Job Fair in Washington, D.C. in January of each),
- Reimburse the United States if you withdraw from the program or fail to qualify for government employment.
- Undergo background investigations as required to obtain security clearances commensurate with internships and post-graduation employment.
- Sign a legal agreement attesting to the above obligations and responsibilities.
